Terms & Conditions:

- The competition opening date is 9 November 2019 and the closing date is 31 December 2019.
- All the competitors must initially fill the registration form and upload the scan of the related document (an identity document like IC, ID card, Citizen Card OR Passport)
- The entry is open to EFL Teachers anywhere in the country.
- There is a limit of one entry to every competitor.
- Competitors must upload their videos on You Tube.
- Competitors must copy the links of their videos in YouTube and paste the links in their <u>registration form</u> and make sure that they have received the delivery Email.

Notice: Links which were sent to the registration form are acceptable.

- Silkroad will not take any responsibilities for damaged, delayed or lost video.
- For phase I, only a 5-minute video is acceptable. The video must include the competitor's oral explanation.
- For phase II, only a 15-minute video is acceptable. The video must include a real, normal English class.

Competition Questions:

The completion includes 2 phases:

- I. In phase I each competitor must choose one of the above mentioned challenges, paraphrase the problem, elaborate how to solve that problem, and finally share their recommendations in a 5-minutes' clip.
- II. In phase II each competitor must submit a 15-minute video, illustrate what they explained in phase 1 in a practical way.







Pre-Competition Checklist

Before uploading your videos, check that you have already taken all of the following matters into consideration.

For phase I:

- Read the challenges carefully and prepare your answers before filming.
- You need to set up your camera in a quiet place where your head and shoulders are visible and try to speak with a loud, clear voice.
- Choose your challenge and explain about it orally and allocated enough time to that. (Totally 5 minutes)
- Place your camera in a stable place and avoid any shaking. It is recommended to use a handheld.

For phase II:

- For phase II film your class. Locate your camera in a place that it can film you, your students and the board.
- The number of present students in your class should not be less than 10.
- Students' first language shouldn't be used by the teacher.
- The film of the teaching time must be just 15 minutes and more than 15 minutes will not be considered.
- Focus on making yourself and your students feel comfortable in front of the camera.
- Give a placement test before, in order to have homogeneous students in the appropriate level. (If having different level in one class is not your challenge)
- Make all the materials ready beforehand
- <u>Download this poster</u> in order to stick it next to your board and make sure it's completely visible during filming.

Note: in terms of good performance, creative design of the activities will be considered as an extra positive point.
